KNOW THE LEGAL BASICS

Short-term travel requires permission from the other parent or the court.

2



GET CONSENT

Always document consent either in writing or via an agreed court order.

3



FILE A MOTION IF NECESSARY

If the other parent objects, petition the court for permission to travel.

4



DRAFT A CLEAR TRAVEL ORDER

Include travel dates, destination, contact information, etc.
